Charges:

1. From on or about November of 2021, until on or about December of 2023, you texted Patient B (i) excessively, (ii) late at night, and/or (iii) with content unrelated to her treatment.

Which constitutes unprofessional conduct for the purposes of section 1(1)(pp)(i), (ii) and/or (xii) of the *Health Professions Act* (the “HPA”) including breaching the College’s:

- Standard of Practice 1.2 – Professional Communication
- Standard of Practice 3.1 – Informed Consent
- Standard of Practice 6.1 – Professional Boundaries with Patients
- Code of Ethics Article A14 – Doctor-patient Boundaries

2. From on or about November of 2021, until on or about December of 2023, you made comments concerning Patient B’s body weight, which were inappropriate and/or which were irrelevant to her treatment.

Which constitutes unprofessional conduct for the purposes of section 1(1)(pp)(i), (ii) and/or (xii) of the *HPA* including breaching the College’s:

- Standard of Practice 1.2 – Professional Communication
- Standard of Practice 4.0 – Provision of Professional Services
- Standard of Practice 6.1 – Professional Boundaries with Patients

3. On or about September 19, 2023, you removed Patient B’s shoes and/or rubbed lotion on her feet:

- a) Without any or any reasonable clinical purpose; and/or
- b) After Patient B explicitly declined consent for the same.

Which constitutes unprofessional conduct for the purposes of section 1(1)(pp)(i), (ii) and/or (xii) of the *HPA* including breaching the College’s:

- Standard of Practice 3.1 – Informed Consent
- Standard of Practice 4.0 – Provision of Professional Services
- Standard of Practice 6.1 – Professional Boundaries with Patients
- Code of Ethics Article A5 – Informed Choice of and Consent for Treatment

Code of Ethics Article A14 – Doctor-patient Boundaries
